COVID-19 BIVALENT Vaccine

The COVID-19 Bivalent vaccine provides protection
against the **original strain of the virus as well as the
Omicron variant**

Initial eligibility criteria: *(as of September 7, 2022)*

- Adults aged 65 or older
- Indigenous People aged 18 or older, regardless of where they live
- Adults of any age with higher-risk medical conditions, including people who are immunocompromised due to a health condition or medication
- Health care workers
- Residents of personal care homes and other congregate living facilities, including group homes, shelters and correctional facilities.

NOTE: Individuals must complete their primary series of vaccine (usually two doses) before they can receive the bivalent vaccine. It is recommended that individuals wait 3 - 6 months from the last dose of vaccine or COVID-19 infection.
